



Valentine's Day and Love

You may be surprised to know the origin of Valentine's Day is entirely pagan. It can be traced back to Lupercalia, an ancient Roman festival that supposedly celebrated and secured fertility. Lupercalia was a weird celebration where boys who were dressed as male goats (the embodiment of sexuality to Romans) ran around slapping people with strips of goat skins. As sordid as that may be, Pope Gelasius I made it a "Christian" feast day in 496. He declared February 14 to be a day to feast and celebrate Saint Valentine. Who was Saint Valentine? Good question, many believe he served as a priest in the 3rd century during the reign of Claudius II, but the details surrounding Saint Valentine are disputed.

So, knowing the seedy history of Valentine's Day you may try to ignore it like I did once. It did not go well for me that fated February 14 many years ago. Men, don't try to skip it; just go with it. The pleasure of skipping this day with pagan origins is not worth the pain.

But I digress.

Where does that leave us? It leaves us where Valentine's Day should leave us, talking about "love." For many love is nothing more than an emotion or feeling that comes and goes. We talk about falling in and out of love and are quick to proclaim "I used to love him/her." We may actually say to another "I don't love you anymore." Thankfully, the Bible tells us in 1 John 4:8 that "God is love." This means that love must be defined by God, and the context of 1 John helps us understand love more completely and accurately.

1 John 4:10 states that God loved us and sent His Son to die as a sacrifice for our sins. Love must be filtered through this act of God to meet our greatest need and do for us what we could not do for ourselves. True love is marked by giving and sacrifice. True love acts to meet the needs of others. True love is not earned. True love continues to serve. In short, true love does not exist outside the realm of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Perhaps there is one good thing that will come out of Valentine's Day this year, a renewed focus on the Lord Jesus and the real meaning of "love." And remember, as Christians God expects us to love as He loves. 1 John 4:8, "Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love."




