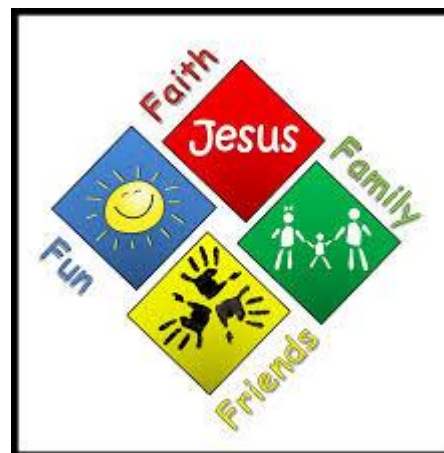

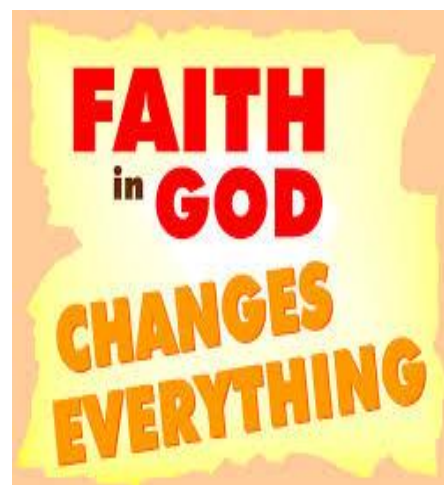

Southern Baptist Convention Recap

Last week Daina and I had the privilege of representing JMBC as messengers to the Southern Baptist Convention in St. Louis. The week began with the pastor's conference- two days full of praise, worship and preaching. Preachers are very hard on themselves and doubly hard on other preachers, so the pastor's conference usually boasts some of the most effective preachers around. Several breakout sessions were offered Monday afternoon as well as a program for pastor's wives. This year the preaching centered on 2 Timothy and the theme of not giving up in the face of challenge and difficulty while remaining focused on Christ. The chance to sit and hear God's Word proclaimed and fellowship with other pastors and their wives was invaluable.

The Southern Baptist Convention convened its annual meeting Tuesday morning with almost 7,500 messengers present. The SBC is two days of business meetings on steroids. Reports are given from each of the six Southern Baptist seminaries, the International Mission Board, North American Mission Board, Lifeway, the Executive Committee, Guidestone, the Ethics and Religious Liberty Commission, and Women's Missionary Union. Mixed in are times of praise, worship, prayer, preaching, and testimonies. All in all it is an encouraging event.

There are also motions made and resolutions passed during the convention. I was proud that our convention stood firm on some key biblical issues. Of particular interest may be the resolution that was passed on biblical sexuality. The SBC is holding fast to a biblical view of marriage and sexuality, but it is also encouraging its members to be loving, kind and understanding to those who are struggling with these issues. There was also much discussion about and a final passing of the resolution on sensitivity and unity concerning the Confederate battle flag. The gist of the resolution (again, I encourage you to read it) is that Christians should not do anything that would harm the cause of Christ or cause unnecessary division in His body.

Throughout the pastor's conference and the SBC there was a focus on the Gospel and the great privilege and responsibility we have as individuals and a local church to share Christ. I came away from the week more aware of this and reminded of the responsibility I have to lead the charge for JMBC in this area. I pray that I will be more sensitive to needs around me and opportunities to share Christ's love and His Gospel, and I am praying that same thing for all of you as well.
