# **CHAMELEON AFFECT**

My mother would often tell me that you "become like those you are around." As a teenager, I had no idea that what she was saying was actually a biblical truth. 1 Corinthians 15:33 states, "Do not be misled: 'Bad company corrupts good character'." Proverbs 22:25 echoes the same idea when it warns against becoming like a "hot-tempered" man by associating with him. Throughout Scripture, there are many other verses that warn God's people against guilt by association and the propensity to be negatively influenced by others. We are charged to guard our hearts and minds in all areas.

I see this phenomenon at work in the Lord's church in many ways, but one circumstance in particular is disconcerting to me. I am calling it the "chameleon affect," but I am certainly not the first to use that term. I have noticed that many of our leaders, people who love Jesus and want to see the Great Commission fulfilled here at JMBC, tend to be chameleon like in their view of the Lord's work. Full disclosure: I will also admit that I fall prey to this subtle pitfall at times myself.

How this tends to play itself out is really quite simple. When we are around optimistic folks who are positive in their view we tend to take that view. However, when we are subjected to naysayers, negativity, and pessimism we also swing over that way ourselves. In other words, we take the view of those we are around (hence, chameleon). Make no mistake, there are challenges faced by the Lord's church. After all, the enemy of our souls is described as a "roaring lion" seeking to bring God's people down. We live in a world under the sway of the evil one, and a spiritual battle is always raging. We were never told in Scripture that serving Jesus would be easy.

I am not advocating that we ignore challenges and problems or pretend they do not exist. However, I am reminding myself and all of you that the Lord is always at work, even in the challenges and tough situations. We must remember that He is sovereign over our challenges and expects us to always act in faith, moving forward to make disciples for Christ. All of this means that we should always be optimistic because we serve a risen Savior who is building His church. My hope for our church is that we will always be joyful, err on the side of faith, and pray every challenge through.

Guard your hearts and keep your focus on the Lord. This will protect you from the chameleon affect.


