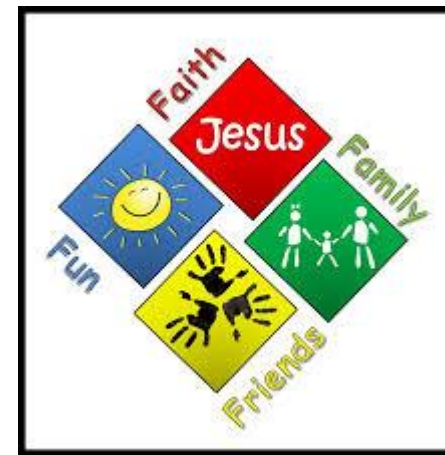

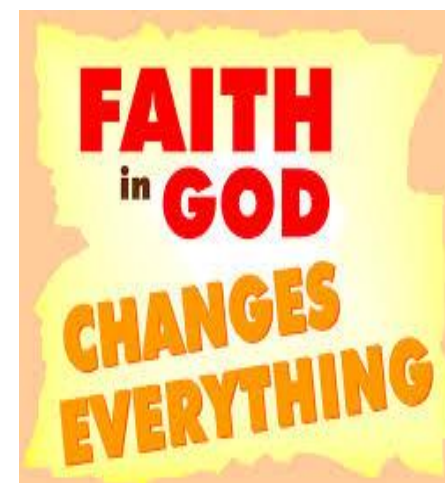

Join us this summer, (July and August), for a change of pace. A light supper will be served on alternating Wednesdays; it will consist of a sandwich, chips/side and a light dessert.

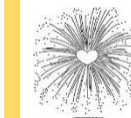
The summer schedule:
