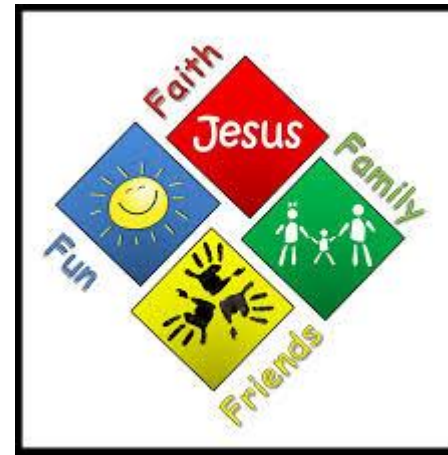

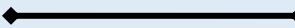

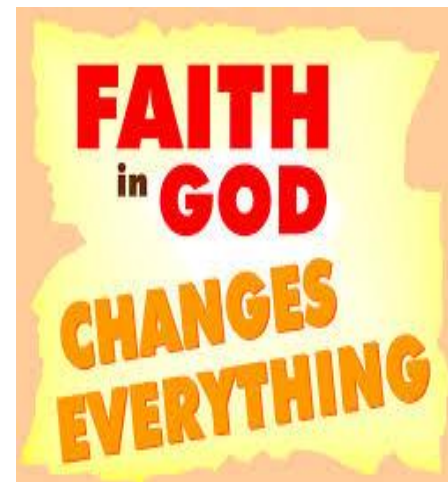

Training like an Olympian

I love athletics and sporting events and always played and competed when given the opportunity. My passion for sports means that I simply cannot look away from the Olympics, I have to watch, eventually getting caught up in national pride and sitting on the edge of my seat as the USA's athletes compete.

The commitment of and sacrifices made by Olympic athletes is incredible. For example, I did some research on an Olympic swimmer and found that she trains six days every week and has done so for the past three years. Her weekly training regimen includes 30 hours of intense workouts of hour-long swim sessions, cross training, and weight training. The athletes who win medals have truly earned them.

In a similar fashion, the Bible commands us to train vigorously in spiritual matters. 1 Timothy 4:7 states "train yourself to be godly." The word translated "train" is the Greek word that is transliterated gymnázō. It is a word that means to exercise or train vigorously. Can you imagine what the Lord would do if His people put the same effort into becoming godly and living for Jesus as athletes training for the Olympic Games!

The takeaway for us is simple. Living the Christian life requires hard work and diligence. Serving as an ambassador for Christ is not something to be taken lightly or approached haphazardly. Instead, we need to approach our lives as Christ-followers as if we are athletes preparing for the Olympics. We must train daily, reading the Word of God and praying, and we must be diligent to gather regularly with God's people to worship. It is also imperative that we guard against things that would set back our training and distract us from our ultimate goal of godliness and faithful living for Christ.

As you watch the Olympic Games remember that we need to train as diligently as those athletes, but we have something more important than a medal on the line. We represent Jesus and carry His message of salvation to the world.
