Day of Prayer: What God Can Do

A.C. Dixon writes: "When we depend upon organizations, we get what organizations can do; when we depend upon education, we get what education can do; when we depend upon man, we get what man can do; but when we depend upon prayer, we get what God can do."

The tendency of many churches and denominations is simply to throw another program at the problem of lack of growth, declining attendance, dwindling numbers of those being saved and baptized, or spiritual lethargy. Now, there is nothing categorically wrong or sinful with new programs and ministries. In fact, I believe there are new programs and ministries that would greatly serve our community and benefit the Lord's work at JMBC. However, if starting a new ministry or program is our go-to solution or standard procedure of operation, we may be off-base and out of line as a church.

In other words, if our new ministries and programs are not born out of a season of prayer where we are ardently seeking God's glory and wisdom from above, we are out of line. John Piper says, "God's purpose is that we get the joy of service but that He gets the glory." We pray because we are seeking God's glory. We pray because we desire to serve and move forward in the strength and wisdom of Christ.

1 Peter 4:11, "Whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength God supplies - in order that in everything God may be glorified..."

Brothers and sisters, this is why we have called for a day of prayer at JMBC. Yes, we are commanded to pray continually and in all things. This day of prayer is simply an opportunity for us to have a time of focused prayer, seeking to honor the Lord and move forward as a church in His strength and for His glory.
